While at CMG Maartje was responsible for the first implementation of TestFrame at the Amsterdam Stock Exchange in 1996. Significantly Maartje brought TestFrame to America with the first implementation at Norwest Financial (Wells Fargo) in 1999. Maartje has implemented TestFrame in 25+ projects globally including NASA. TestFrame itself has been implemented in over 1000 projects globally.
